4. Updates:
 - Continue to reviewing clinical and financial software programs (budgeted for 2007)
 - Outdoor furniture for main entrance area under the pergala area- has arrived, purchased with memorial donations
 - IDPH hearing with Administrative law judge on involuntary discharge of a resident- result of hearing was in Hillcrest's favor to discharge resident. James Cosby represented Hillcrest during the hearing, which took place at Hillcrest
 - Halloween Trick or Treat night at Hillcrest- over 100 children trick or treated up and down the hallways while residents passed out candy

6. Two special donations in October:
 - GIFT Foundation of Geneseo and Wells Fargo Bank (Sherrard Grant)- Hillcrest received a grant for \$24,000 to purchase a walk-in freezer for the Kitchen and also to help purchase 10 resident beds.
 - Bill and Susan Philhower- \$5000 donation to help purchase resident beds. These bed are called low-rise beds and have the ability to lower within seven inches of the floor and are used to help prevent resident falls from bed/climbing out of bed
