4. Updates:

- Proposal regarding demolition of old building. Per Bill Hawkinson of Kenyon Architects, Peoria Il: The building is not unique enough to have any historic value. The cost to renovate the old building would be as much as it would be to build a new building.
- With the assistance of Phil Hare's office, we have submitted an application for funds (\$125,000) to help with demolition costs of the old building. 10/01/08 would be the soonest funds would be available.
- No "revisit user fees" for nursing homes: CMS will not be charging skilled nursing facilities for revisit user fees now that President Bush has signed the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2008 into law. According to the House Committee on Rules, the funding measure does not include language granting CMS the authority to charge fees to cover the cost of revisits. The controversial fees had been set at \$168 for an off-site revisit survey and \$2,072 for an on-site survey.
- Applied for the Innovations in Long Term Care Grant Program through IDPH (\$50,000) to help with costs of new clinical/financial software and equipment for Hillcrest. We have narrowed the field of software vendors down to two choices, and will have a recommendation for the next meeting.
- Annex Roof Repairs- Inspection of SW corner of facility by Goodyear (yearly warranty inspection) found roof to be in need of repairs by Oldeen, which they have completed.
- Problem with frame on pickup truck used to plow snow, will try to switch blade to our other pickup.
