Our IDPH plan of correction for the tag we received for the nursing portion of our survey (doctors to set parameters for blood glucose testing) has been accepted and we are back in compliance.

7. Submitted grant application to IDPH for "Light Makes Life Better" for \$100,000. If approved the grant would address Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD) and depression in nursing home residents. We would replace all interior lighting with full spectrum lighting and increase resident access to outdoor light/sunshine by installing automatic doors to our courtyard and replace the uneven concrete sidewalks in the courtyard and on the front lawn. We would also purchase outdoor lawn furniture such as benches, chairs, and umbrella tables for both areas and landscape.
