The Transportation Committee of the Henry County Board met in the office of the County Engineer on June 9, 2022. Chairman Jeff Orton called the meeting to order at 3:11 PM with the following members present:

County Engineer Report:

S. Stephenson informed the committee of the following:

- Wind turbines are starting to go up in the Midland Wind Farm project.
- Maintainer II positions are still available. Black Hawk College-East Campus is offering a CDL Class this summer. This office has informed them of our openings. We also plan to advertise, again for the positions in a couple weeks.
- Hired three summer interns for the summer.
- Road crews completed HMA paving for Colona Township and the Village of Annawan. This week we started seal coating in Alba Township.
- Distributed and reviewed budget reports for all accounts. Discussion followed.

Old Business

- R. Elliott has heard complaints that the paint lines on Wolf Road are faded. S. Stephenson reported that this year's traffic marking paint has just been approved by IDOT and should be delivered to our yard in the near future.
- The soil borings are complete on the Sears bottom project. Discussion followed.
- S. Stephenson met with Ecology Solutions and discussed with IDOT the contractor's recommendation for improvements to the I80 slope fail project. Ecology Solutions is in agreement, and IDOT is currently reviewing the recommendations. Discussion followed.

New Business

On Tuesday, June 7, 2022, at 9:00 am the 2022 Bituminous Surface Removal (Cold Milling) Letting was held in the office of the County Engineer. S. Stephenson distributed and recommended the committee

award to the low bidder. N. Collins moved to recommend the Board award Dunn Company of Decatur the 2022 Cold Milling project for \$98,980.80. R. Elliott seconded.
